From the East



One of the tough issues to face at any time, but especially during a time of inflation, is money. Part of our responsibilities as Masons is to provide for our future and that includes being fiscally responsible.

Our Stated Meeting in September included the discussion of rising costs for dinners. We all know that food prices are rising and it is no longer possible to provide a meal for \$10. We hope that our new dinner cost of \$15 will sustain us.

The dues we pay each year include the Per Capita assessment of Grand Lodge. While the amount we pay has gone up approximately \$5 each year none of that amount has been retained by the Lodge to pay our bills and expenses, it has all gone to the Per Capita. Per Capita is currently \$60 which represents almost half of our total dues. The actual dues amount is \$70 and has not changed since 2009. We will be voting on a dues increase in October to be effective January 1, 2024. A letter has been sent to every Brother of Lodi Lodge. All Brethren are encouraged to attend the October meeting and vote.

This is probably not the best time to bring up the subject of the Annual Fund of Grand Lodge which supports our Masonic Homes and scholarships but better now than never. At the conclusion of the Master Mason Degree the Master invited you to sign the By-Laws of the Lodge and told you that by doing so it would subject you to its burdens and responsibilities as well as entitle you to its benefits and privileges.

Your contribution provides for the charitable causes of California Masonry and ensures the comfort and well-being of those in our Masonic Homes.

So, is the Annual Fund a "burden" or "privilege"? Personally, it is my privilege to continue the good works created by our California Brethren more than 100 years ago. If all the Officers make a donation Lodi Lodge will appear on the "100% Officer Giving Honor Roll". If one misses we will not be so designated. It is up to you. Any amount will qualify. Deadline is October 1, 2023.

Some donations were made at the Oroville casino.







DUES INCREASE - AMENDMENT TO BY-LAWS

The following amendment to the By-Laws of Lodi Lodge No. 256 F. & A. M. was presented at the stated meeting on the 7th day of September 2023 to amend, Article III Section 2:

The dues of each member of this Lodge shall be the sum of \$90.00 per annum, plus the Per Capita sum approved by Grand Lodge at the immediately preceding Annual Communication, payable in advance on the first day of January.

The members of this Lodge are hereby notified in writing that this amendment will be voted upon at the Stated Meeting held on the 5th day of October 2023 and requires an affirmative vote of 2/3 of the members present.

This amendment will have no effect until approved by the Grand Lodge or the Grand Master and transmitted to the Grand Secretary.
