LODI LODGE #256 History.

Abridged REPRINT from a 2004 Lodi Sentinel News Article:

In the spring of 1879, 12 Lodi men brought one of the oldest and most respected men's organizations in American history to town when they organized a local lodge of the Masonic Order.

Celebrating 125 years of active Masonry in Lodi, the Lodi Masonic Lodge invites the public to attend its open house from 1 to 4 p.m. today at 321 W. Pine St. Special exhibits of local Masonic history and collectibles will be on display in the lodge meeting area on the second floor.

More farmers and merchants settled in the northern San Joaquin County, and in 1869 Lodi was founded when the railroad was built. As the population grew, the desire for social interactions and fellowship grew. In the early 1870s, there were two men's organizations in Lodi, the International Order of Odd Fellows and the Knights of Pythias. Members had to ride horses or buggies to Woodbridge or Lockeford several miles away to attend meetings because there was no meeting place in Lodi.

Lodi's first meeting hall was built in 1876. The brick Granger's building was at the southwest corner of Sacramento and Elm streets and had a general merchandise store on the ground floor. The upstairs had a meeting room known as the Lodi Hall. Here, the Odd Fellows, Knights of Pythias and by then the third organization in Lodi, the Good Templars held their meetings.

With an established meeting hall and a growing population, it was time for Lodi to have its own Masonic lodge. On March 7, 1879, 12 men who were members of other lodges in neighboring towns met in Lodi Hall to form a local lodge.

The Lodi Lodge No. 256 Free & Accepted Masons held its first official meeting on Oct. 16, 1879 in Lodi Hall. Benjamin F. Langford, a member of the Woodbridge Masonic Lodge and the founder of Lodi's first bank, represented California's Grand Master John M. Browne at the meeting.


Ralph Ellis, who ran the Lodi Flour Mill, was installed as the first Master of the Lodi Lodge. Less than two years after this meeting, Ellis started the Lodi Sentinel newspaper. Other prominent Lodi men took active roles at that meeting. Charles O. Ivory, Lodi's first merchant, was named senior deacon. David Kettelman, early landowner, cattle rancher and strong supporter of local schools, was junior deacon. Ezekiel Lawrence, a pioneer landowner since 1857 and strong supporter of schools, was named treasurer. Col. L. O. Gillespie, pioneer watermelon grower, was named lodge steward.

The Lodi Masonic Lodge met once a month on the Thursday evening after the full moon. With this plan, there was always good moonlight in order to see the road when traveling to and from the meetings.

In 1938, 59 years after the first Lodi Masons met, the Lodi Masonic Lodge completed its own building. Located at 321 W. Pine St. next to the Woman's Club of Lodi, the Masonic Building has two floors. The first floor office was rented out to doctors and dentists who were also Masons. The second floor was devoted to the lodge meeting hall. This building today continues to be used in the same manner, but renters are not required to be Masons.

Now marking its 125th year, the Lodi Masonic Lodge No. 256 continues to hold regular social functions. There are

approximately 200 members of the lodge today.
