

United Grand Lodge of England



Friendship Punchbowl, 1813

This punchbowl is well travelled. It was made by a Chinese Craftsman in 1813 and taken by ship to India for use by the Lodge of True Friendship.



Sussex Plate

The 1st Duke of Sussex was given this plate after 25 years as Grand Master of the United Grand Lodge of England. It weights 56Kg (124lbs) solid silver.



The Sword of State, 1730

This sword was presented to the Grand Lodge of England in 1730, less than a decade after the creation of the Constitutions. It has been carried into every Quarterly Communication of Grand Lodge from that date as a symbol of the Grand Master's authority. It underlines the strength and continuity of English Freemasonry as a consequence of the Constitutions.
