At the May Stated Meeting all attending Past Masters were presented with a token of appreciation for they're commitment to the craft.

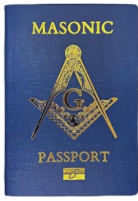
We take a moment to honor a group of men whose dedication, leadership, and steady guidance have shaped the very foundation of Lodi Lodge #256—our Past Masters.

To our Past Masters: thank you for your dedication, your guidance, and your example. Your legacy will continue to shape the future.

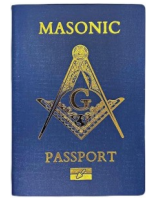
